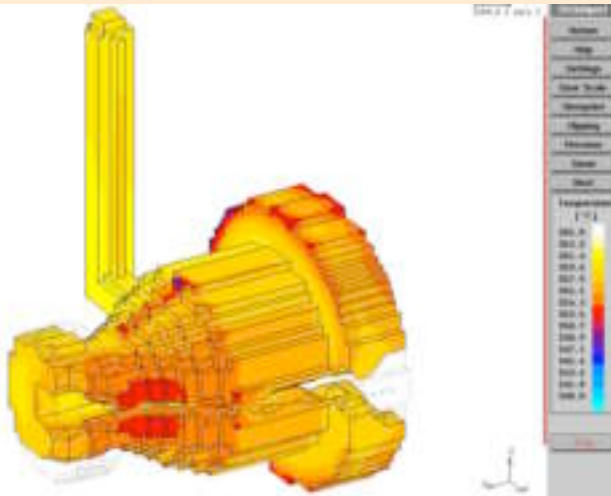
Research in Europe is all most *same* as in Japan.
